Current Projects

Scholarship Program

- Provides partial scholarships to over 100 students from Kindergarten to university level
- Students are from rural,
 Indigenous regions including
 K'iche' and Mam areas as well as
 the city of Xela
- Parents attend monthly meetings to monitor the students' academic progress and join in educational workshops and activities

Family Support Center (FSC)

- A holistic program for 32 children and their families in Llanos del Pinal
- Hot lunches & snacks, academic support, and extra-curricular activities are provided
- Staff promote active learning through movement, art, and experiential learning using Waldorf Education principles

Nutrition Program

- Treats children up to 5 years old for chronic & acute malnutrition in rural, Indigenous regions including K'iche' and Mam areas
- Monitors height, weight, and hemoglobin levels as well as provides well-child checkups
- Distributes food and supplements for all children in the program
- Conducts educational workshops for parents

Environmental Projects

- Agroecological family, community, and urban gardens with families in the Nutrition Program and the Family Support Center
- Educational workshops with a focus on food sovereignty
- Reforestation with native species



32 Volcanes Clinic

- Provides free and low-cost medical care for patients with acute and chronic health concerns, including mobile clinics for chronically ill patients in San Juan Ostuncalco
- Mental health care and physical therapy are also available
- Provides free well-visits for FSC and Scholarship Program participants

Health Scholarships
